support his/her argument?	
Comment on the author's intended	
data sources. Does the author use (or	
plan to use) primary sources, library	
books, and at least one professional	
journal article? Can you recommend	
other potential data sources?	
Is the abstract written in an	
academically appropriate tone and	
style? Does it provide a succinct sense	
of the paper's motivation, main	
argument, and findings?
